It has been a blessing to be back in our home area for the beginning of the Fall season. We have been refreshed to be back with friends and family who we have not seen for a few months. We started the month of September with our favorite meeting on deputation so far. Of course, we could be biased, but it was a wonderful missions conference at our home church of First Baptist in Seymour, IA. This was a splendid time with our church family, missionaries that were back on a quick furlough, and a couple of new missionaries to our church. We are blessed to be a part of such a missions-minded church! We then made our way to the Eastern side of Kansas where we were at a few churches for a week. We were encouraged to have one of those churches vote to take us on for support immediately after the service!

Growing up in church, I have heard it said before that there will be times when you feel like you are on a mountaintop of blessings and that that will be followed by a valley of testing and trial. Such has been the case for us this month. Midway through the month of September, we were traveling back through lowa, when we were met by a deer running into the front of our van.
